Vendors are chosen to provide a balance of products at BACC discretion.

Each vendor will be notified via e-mail or phone if they have been accepted to the Festival **no later than July 15, 2010.**

Late applicants will be charged a \$100 late fee and will be accepted/assigned booth space on a first-come-first-served basis.

**Your check or money order made payable to B.A.C.C. Vendor fee is due and payable at the time you submit your application.** The Festival is held rain or shine and vendor fees are non-refundable. Please be prepared for inclement weather and install your booth to stand up to wind, rain, cold or heat. The BACC is not responsible for damaged exhibits.

- Vendors provide own set-up equipment (tent, tables, chairs, etc)
- Vendors to remain on-site and open for business until 5:00 PM Sunday afternoon.
- Booths must be open for business at 10:00 AM and staffed during Festival hours (10-5)
- Early set up is from 2-5 PM on Friday, September 3, 2010. (No overnight security provided)
- Regular set-up is from 6:30 AM to 9:30 AM Saturday and Sunday.
- All vehicles, other than those behind "Growers' Row" must be off the field by 9:00 AM Saturday and Sunday.
- **NO DOGS** – This is private property.
- Vendors must dispose of their trash in the **DUMPSTERS** provided by the barns. Fee will be charged to you for garbage left at booth or field garbage cans.
- Electricity is not available. If you need power, you must provide a quiet generator and please notify the Festival Coordinator.
- Vendors agree to acquire all applicable licenses.
- Subletting of booth space is strictly prohibited.
- No amplified systems allowed in the festival (bullhorns, radios, CD players, etc).
